Goals: CRC provides financial support to special needy schools (visually challenged, hearing impaired, orphanage) in India and set up a recycling knowledge center/library in rural area public high schools to promote recycling awareness.

In 2014, our team raised \$6315 and helped 600 families in Hudhud cyclone impacted villages in Visakhaptnam area, AP, India and 11 schools: (1 visually challenged, 3 hearing impaired, 2 physically challenged, 1 orphanage, 4 public high schools). 
