<u> 2019 – 2020 CRC Ambassador Program</u>

Purpose: The main purpose of the CRC Ambassador Program is to foster learning and civic engagement through community service, volunteerism and leadership in highly motivated middle and high school students. CRC Ambassadors will develop, initiate and manage a significant community service project. All ambassadors will receive monthly training on various topics include: high school/college planning, how to write a business plan, leadership, philanthropy, media, fundraising, and register ambassadors' service projects as non-profits.

- Comprehensive High School/College Planning Guidance and Counseling Program for all selected ambassadors:
 - > Guide ambassadors to create a road map for High School/College Planning
 - ✓ Provide educational resources including scholarships, summer programs...
 - ✓ Encourage ambassadors to participate in various contests including science fairs
 - ✓ Record volunteer hours and provide recommendations to apply scholarships
- Guidance to lead a Service Project:
 - > Guide ambassadors to lead a service project
 - Each ambassador will create a team and work on their own service project Service projects including:
 - Raise funds to support special needs/disabilities schools (Blind, Deaf, Orphanage, Mentally Challenged) in USA and abroad
 - ✓ Raise funds to set up a library in CRC adopted public high schools
 - ✓ Advocacy on environmental issues
 - ✓ Computer/Clothes/Books Recycling
 - ✓ Service at Senior Nursing homes, Home Less shelters, and Food Banks
 - ✓ Mentoring juniors and other needy students for academic success

The training process is designed to take place over the course of approximately one year (March to Feb) from the date of acceptance. The following timelines are to be used as a guideline of the time commitment for the 2019-20CRC Ambassador Program. Upon successful completion of program and ambassadors who complete training requirements will be recognized on the public stage. After graduation, all ambassadors will continue their service project to help more people.

- Each Ambassador should be able to spend at least 2 hours/week to work on their community service project
- Each ambassador must participate in all online seminars. Ambassadors who miss two online seminars in a row or total 3 out of designed seminars will exit from the program.
- Each ambassador must actively participate in all online seminars.
